Vera DUBEUX is Professor at the Federal University of Alagoas (UFAL) - Centre of Agricultural Sciences (CECA), Brazil, for courses of Agronomy, Animal Science and Agricultural Engineering since 1990 and since 2014 for the Master's Programme on Biomass energies. His main research since 1983 have been developed in the field of sugar cane in the National Programme for Improvement of Sugarcane (Planalsucar) today "Interuniversity Network for the Development of Industry Sugar and Alcohol" (Ridesa). This network is composed of Federal Universities of regions of Brazil producing sugarcane. The Ridesa is responsible for the creation of the cane variety RB, Republic of Brazil.

- *In 2015, Vera Dubeux Torres is elected Corresponding Member of the French "Académie d'Agriculture de France".*
